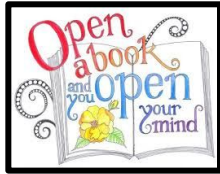


LITERACY

COMPULSORY - complete all activities in this box

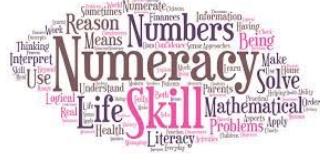
- Read for between 10 - 20 mins each night.
